After running for three successful consecutive years, the week-long residency for creative producers returns to Coombe Farm Studios in Dittisham, Devon in June 2019. The programme aims to provide time and space to consider your current work and future potential.

- Dedicated time to reflect on and refresh your ideas and practice

- People with a strong desire to expand their capacity and capabilities as creative producers
- People excited by reaching audiences through the power and quality of new work
- People who are open to new ideas and sharing with their peers

Financial Information:

The residency is free, and participants will be provided with accommodation and all food. We can support travel costs for UK participants from Totnes (the nearest train station to the residency). For producers based outside the UK, we can support costs from London. How to apply

Please send a short CV and the completed application form. In the form you should aim to demonstrate how you match the criteria and outline how this residency will benefit you and your work in the future. You will need to commit to the full week of the residency. A panel consisting of representatives from the participating organisations will make the selection. The initial assessment of applications will be made based on track record to date, potential for development and rationale for attending. Consideration will also be given to selecting a diverse and balanced cohort of participants.
