After running for five successful consecutive years, the week-long residency for creative producers returns to Coombe Farm Studios in Dittisham, Devon in June 2020. The programme aims to provide time and space to consider your current work and future potential.

How to apply

Please send a short CV and the completed application form. In the form you should aim to demonstrate how you match the criteria and outline how this residency will benefit you and your work in the future. You will need to commit to the full week of the residency. A panel consisting of representatives from the participating organisations will make the selection. The initial assessment of applications will be made based on track record to date, originality of thinking, potential for development and rationale for attending. Consideration will also be given to selecting a diverse and balanced cohort of participants.
